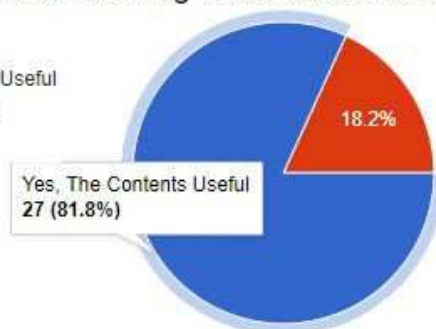

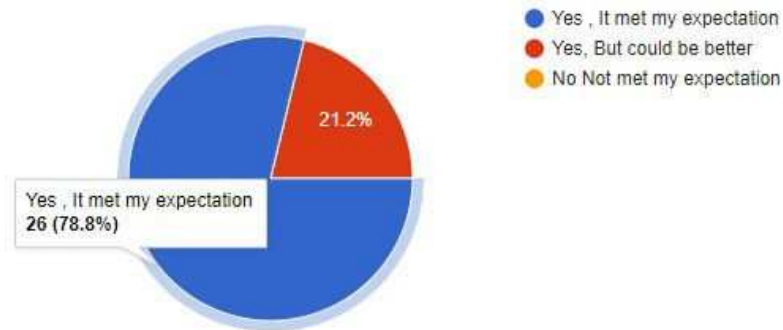

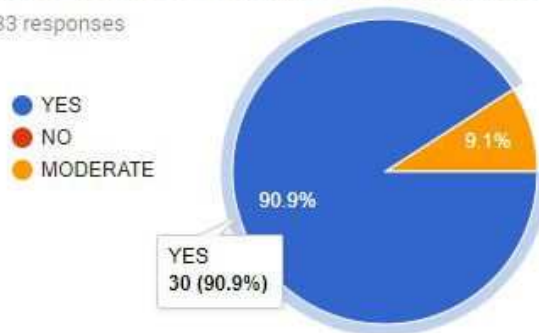

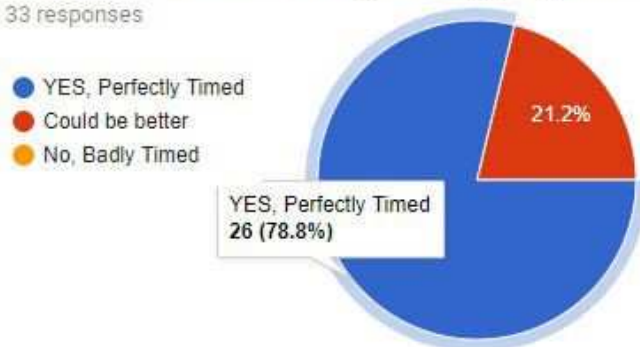

### Duration of the Training was appropriate

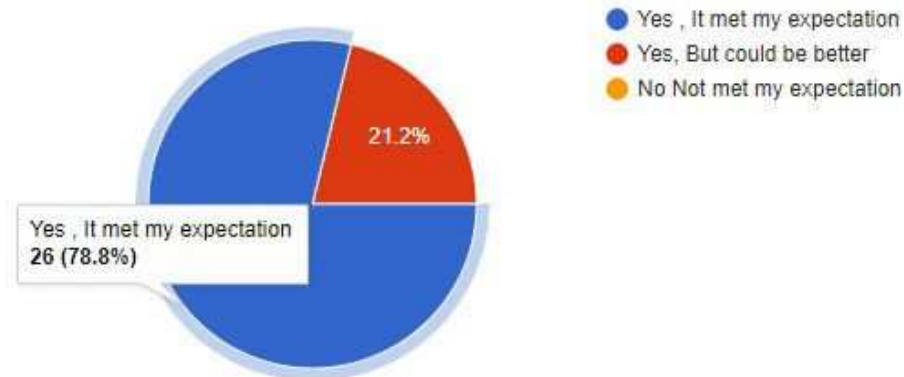

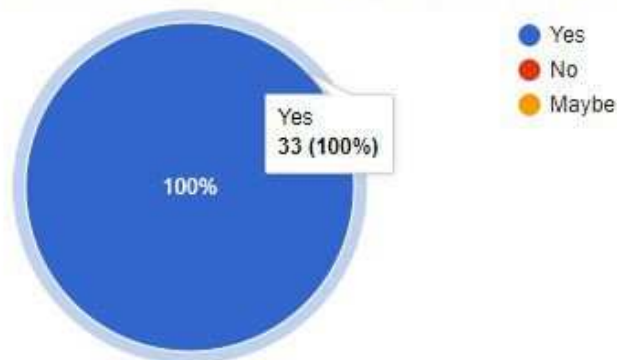

## Presentation materials were understandable & interesting

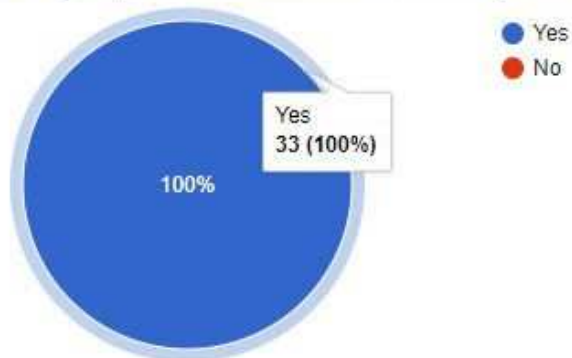

## Trainer was well prepared & able to answer your queries

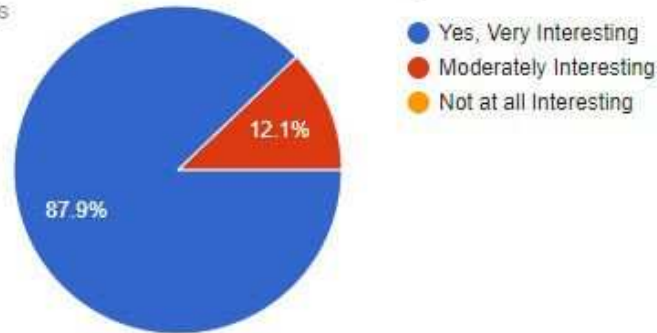

### Trainer was interactive & interesting

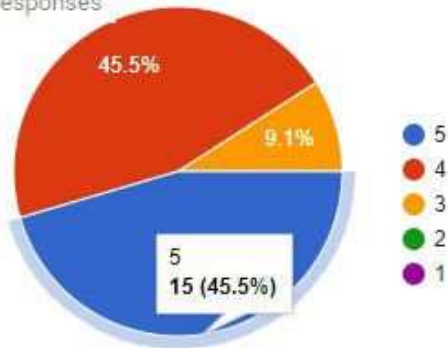

### Overall Rating of the Trainer

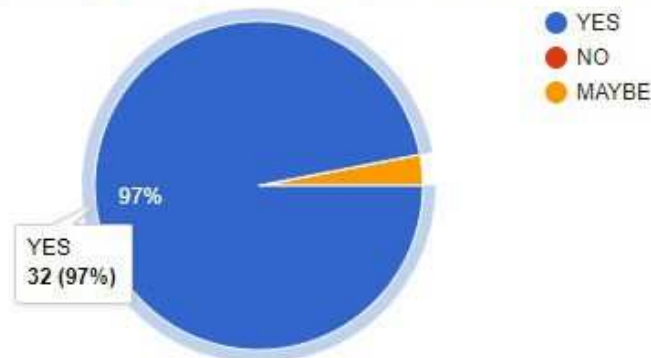
